This is a two track class.

Both classes will use Alpha Omega Publications LIFEPACS, Spanish I Worktexts. Your student will begin the serious study of this foreign language. Class time will consist of dictation, grammar, vocabulary, conversation, games, projects, interactive activities, cultural appreciation and celebrations, and more. Sarah will do an excellent job of fully exposing your student to the Spanish language and culture! Student's progress will be monitored, tests will be administered and grades will be assigned. Homework is mandatory. A full year of Spanish half is equivalent to one semester of high school Spanish. This curriculum is designed to be completed independently and students are free to complete the 10 LIFEPACS in one year, in order to complete a full credit of high school Spanish.
